DAY 04: DUBAI - JOHANNESBURG - VICTORIA FALLS

Morning on arrival in Johannesburg airport connect with your flight to Victoria Falls. On arrival at Victoria Falls, guests will be met by your representative and transferred to lodge. Rest of the afternoon at leisure to relax. This afternoon embark on a relaxing sunset cruise that departs from the lodge. Guest will be transferred from the hotel to the mighty Zambezi River. The Zambezi River cruise is a superb way to relax and enjoy the beauty of the river. Guests may have the opportunity to see a variety of game; including hippo, crocodile, and elephant and sometimes even rhino in their home environment, as well as enjoy the many different bird species. DAY 05: VICTORIA FALLS

After breakfast the group will be collected and transferred to the Victoria Falls for a guided tour of the falls. On the opposite cliff, facing the falls, you can take a well-marked and paved walk through the rain forests. Every so often the path will open out into a clearing for a view of the falls. Further along this path is the Knife Edge Bridge which affords an impressive panorama depending on the time of year. Although less can be seen of the width of the Falls during the wet season, the intense spray provides welcome relief from the heat, but don't carry anything you don't want to get wet! The rest of the afternoon will be at leisure to relax at the lodge. Later this evening the group will enjoy their dinner at the lodge. Overnight in Victoria Falls



DAY 06: VICTORIA FALLS - JOHANNESBURG

After breakfast transfer by road to Victoria Falls Airport for the outward flight to Johannesburg. Upon arrival, you will be met by our representative and transferred to your hotel. Check-In and enjoy the remainder of the day at your leisure. Overnight in Johannesburg

Optional: (If time permits) Two hours tour - 70 CAD per person on SIC Basis:

South Africa's largest city remains its financial and commercial heart. It's in this fast-paced metropolis that the country's radical political and social transformation is most evident – this is the 'Rainbow Nation' at work. It's a heady experience, with contrasts of every kind round every single corner. Our tour sets off for Constitution Hill, home of South Africa's architectural marvel, the Constitutional Court and site of Johannesburg's Old Fort Prison (closed Sundays). We explore the inner city of Johannesburg and the influence the discovery of gold brought to this city and indeed South Africa. We visit and explore the Maboneng Precinct, a wonderful example of urban regeneration of the eastside of the Johannesburg CBD which is now home to several independent retail, restaurant, art and entertainment venues – fresh and unique lifestyle offerings of this new exciting development.

DAY 07: JOHANNESBURG - HAZYVIEW

This morning enjoy an orientation tour of Soweto. SOWETO an acronym for South Western Township, is home to over 2 million people, who, despite living in crowded and chaotic conditions, have a tangible sense of community, one which ironically, the ordered, walled, northern suburbs lack. Drive past the Hector Pieterson Museum and Mandela House before leaving the commercial hub to travel into the Mpumalanga region. Continue on through Graskop to Hazyview, just outside Kruger National Park. Overnight in Hazyview

DAY 08: KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

The world-renowned Kruger National Park offers a wildlife experience that ranks with the best in Africa. There are approximately 147 mammal species here, including the 'Big 5': lion, elephant, buffalo, leopard and rhino (black & white). Spend your day game viewing from your coach in this unspoilt 20,000 square kilometer park. You may be lucky and spot Africa's 'Big Five' - the exhilaration of seeing wildlife at close range is a truly unforgettable experience!
